

## Intra-Club Permit (ICP)

## Rules for using the ICP

- 1. The purpose of the ICP is for the development of players within a Club.
- 2. The ICP can only be used to bring up players on a single game basis, from a Club team playing in a lower Division, to a Club team playing in a higher Division, as spelled out in the MWSL Operating Rules (Section 3.8)
- The ICP can only be used to bring up players who are registered in the MWSL and does not apply to players who are registered on a Youth team from within the same Club.
- ICP's are for use in League games only.
- ICP's cannot be used in Cup games.
- 6. There is no limit to the number of times a player can be brought up on an ICP during a season.
- 7. A maximum of 5 players may be brought up for any one game.
- 8. Players cannot play on a Club team in a lower Division using this form.
- Players on a higher Division team wishing to play on a lower Division team must use an official BC Soccer Transfer Form as per BC Soccer's - Rules and Regulations -Rule 7.
- 10. There is no fee for use of this form.
- 11. Two (2) copies of this form must be given to the Referee before the start of the game.
- 12. Players playing up on an ICP must present their MWSL I.D. cards to the referee for inspection.
